How to book?

Step 1 – Confirm you live in the Canada Bay area

Book your collection via the booking form on the HomeCycle website. Collections are limited to one booking per week, per address.

Step 2 – Pack your items

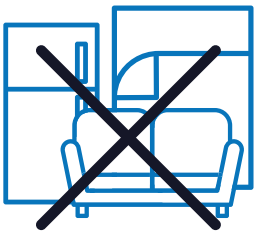
Where possible, box or bag items separately, as they go to different places. Leave items outside in a safe and accessible spot near your front door the night before your collection day.

Step 3 – The accepted items will be collected

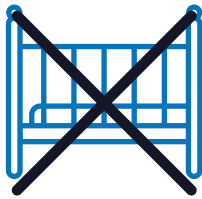
on your booked collection day and an SMS notification will be sent once items are collected.

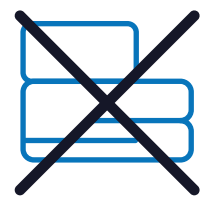

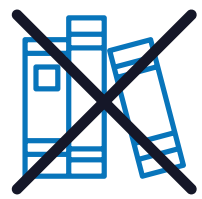
