



HomeCycle is a FREE home pick up service for Whitehorse residents to donate household items in good condition for reuse by charities and locals needing emergency relief. The service runs from 7 August until 6 November 2024.

What we do pick up

Acceptable items



Clean & reusable clothing



Fashion accessories (i.e. hats, bags, belts, scarves and jewellery)

Musical instruments



Worn &

Whitegoods (i.e. single door fridge, washing machine, dryer)

Student desk & chair

Shoes (pairs and odds)



Small furniture (in good condition)



Dining table set (max 6 chairs)



Bedside table & tallboy



(i.e.crockery, cutlery, utensils)



Bikes (all sizes)



Baby items & hard toys (i.e. pram, stroller, car seat, cot)





HomeCycle picks up your preloved clothes, reusable household goods and electronic waste, and diverts them from landfill by donating your goods to be reused and re-purposed by Eastern Emergency Relief Network.

How to book?

Step 1 - Book your collection

Book by scaning the QR code below and booking on the website or call **(03) 9386 8702.**

Step 2 – Pack your items

Place accepted items outside in a safe and accessible spot near your front door the night before your collection day.

Step 3 – Accepted items will be collected

on your booked collection day and an SMS notification will be sent once items are collected.

Books & records

Collections are limited to 2 cubic metres and one pick-up per household.
